

## UNIFORM



Every pupil is expected to wear school uniform. Having a uniform contributes towards the tone of the school and good order. From September 2014 it will be *compulsory* for Year 7, 8 and 9 pupils to wear *clip-on* ties, which will be available to purchase *only* from school. The school also has a “jumper shop” selling excellent quality jumpers, slippers and cardigans embroidered with the school logo, at very competitive prices.



### Girls Uniform

**Plain black school skirt** (*appropriately modest length*) or  
**Black school trousers** (*no jeans/leggings*)  
**White blouse/shirt** (*tucked in*)  
**School *Clip-on* tie** (*Only available from school*)  
**Black v-necked school jumper/slipover or cardigan** (*with school badge*)  
**Black or white socks**  
**Black tights**  
**Flat black footwear** (*No trainers*)  
**Plain black or navy coat or School hooded top** (*with school badge - names can be printed on the back, but no nicknames*)

### Boys Uniform

**Black school trousers**  
**White shirt** (*tucked in*)  
**School *Clip-on* tie** (*Only available from school*)  
**Black v-necked school jumper/slipover** (*with school badge*)  
**Black socks**  
**Black shoes** (*no trainers*)  
**Plain black or navy coat or School hooded top** (*with school badge - names can be printed on the back, but no nicknames*)

### In addition

- On the grounds of health and safety, and security, no jewellery is allowed. Pupils can wear a wristwatch.
- Inappropriate hairstyles, for example tramlines or extreme hair colouring, will not be tolerated and could lead to exclusion. Hair must be clean and dressed to keep it out of eyes and off faces.
- No cosmetics are allowed.
- No tattoos.
- Trainers are not allowed except for PE lessons.
- Mobile phones and other expensive possessions, such as MP3 players and iPods, are not allowed in school. If any of these items are confiscated parents will be asked to come to school to collect them. All valuables should be kept at home as the school will not accept responsibility for loss, theft or damage to these items.
- Parents need to provide a note for their child should they, for any particular reason, be unable to wear uniform. Pupils who do not wear the correct uniform to school will be sent home to change.
