INFORMATION REGARDING THE PUPIL DEVELOPMENT GRANT

(PDG 2018-2019)

- The total number of pupils on school roll for September 2018 is 127
- The school's FSM population is 16 (under 25%)
- This is equal to the population of the previous year.
- The total allocation of PDG to this school is £19,800
- The school undertakes the following activities in order to support pupils facing the challenges of poverty and deprivation.

These include

- Catch Up support in Mathematics for identified FSM pupils as well as for pupils in previous years who have been eligible for FSM, who are performing just below the average range within their year group
- Catch Up Reading support for identified FSM pupils as well as for pupils in previous years who have been eligible for FSM, who have a reading age and or comprehension age below their chronological age. This intervention is run in year 2&3
- Rainbow Reading support is provided for pupils in Key Stage 2 for identified FSM pupils as well as for pupils in previous years who have been eligible for FSM, who have a reading age and or comprehension age below their chronological age
- Deployment and funding for teaching assistants to deliver these interventions
- Deployment of additional practitioner in early years class to provide individual and small group speech and language sessions in order to improve pupils literacy skills.

The school's Pupil Development Grant (PDG) and Education Improvement Grant (EIG) plans are regularly scrutinised by the Governing Body, supported by advice from EAS and monitored by the Local Authority
