

## RCCS FAQs: Welsh Assembly Uniform Grant.

### Who is entitled to claim the Welsh Assembly Uniform Grant?

The Scheme provides a grant to each pupil entering Year 7 of secondary school in Wales who is eligible for free school meals. Accordingly children of families in receipt of:-

- Child Tax Credit only (**NOT** Working Tax Credit) Where the total annual income is less than £16,190
- Income Support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.



### How do I claim?

RCCS uses the reimbursement scheme. Parents/carers must:-

- Provide receipts for all uniform purchased.
- Provide the confirmation of entitlement letter they receive from CCBC.
- Submit a Welsh Assembly Uniform Grant claim form (available from the school)

### When will I receive the reimbursement cheque?

RCCS usually collate the necessary documentation during September. Once all documents have been authorised they are sent to CCBC for payment. The reimbursement cheque will be issued from CCBC and not from the school. This can take up to two weeks after authorisation.



### How much can I claim?

The total amount available to claim for September 2010 entry is £105.00.
