LETTER TO PARENTS JOINING US IN 2014

Thursday 12th December 2013

Dear Parent / Carer,

We are delighted you have chosen our school for next September, and I am pleased to be able to welcome you with some really good news. The Welsh Government has today released information on the banding of secondary schools and we have now moved up into Band Two following our best ever GCSE performance for the second successive year last summer. This reflects an increase in our L2+ (five GCSEs at grade C or above including English and Maths) of a further 4% after last year's massive 12% rise, and increases in all other major indicators, including a 5% increase at L1 (five GCSEs) and a particularly impressive 19% rise in L2 (five GCSEs at grade C or above) as well as very good attendance across all year groups.

We take most pride however in our impressive value-added data, and our focus remains firmly on the achievements and well-being of each individual child who joins us rather than on whole school figures.

Nevertheless, when these individual successes lead to big improvements in the school's aggregated performance as in 2013 and 2012 it is encouraging for the whole school community, and our current pupils are not only eager to improve on the achievements of last year's leavers, they are on track to do so.

You can therefore be confident that in September 2014 your child will be joining a school which is constantly seeking ways to improve and which is making rapid progress.

There will of course be opportunities to meet and familiarise both you and your child with the school again before then. In the meantime, I would like to wish you and your family a very Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.
