Dear Parent/Carer,

You may be aware that the NUT is planning to take industrial action across the UK on Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> March. A large number of RCCS teachers are due to be involved in this and they will not be in school that day.

I have therefore decided that the only reasonable course of action I can take is to close the school to most pupils as we will be unable to supervise a large number of children for a great part of the timetabled day. However, teachers who are not taking action and who have examination classes in Y11 that day will be available to teach their classes and where at all possible these older students should make every effort to be in school to attend those lessons only. College courses for Y10 will run as usual. Final details will be communicated directly to these students themselves early next week, and I have attached a draft copy of the Y11 timetable below. Lunch will be available as usual for those students who have a lesson before and after the designated lunch break.

Wherever possible work will be set to be completed at home for the lessons pupils miss, either as paper based homework or as a web-based assignment

If arrangements change we will let you know through the normal channels (social media and text message.) I am sure that any postponement of the NUT action would also be announced in the media.
