As you are aware Estyn inspected our school in March and the report has now been published on their website, and we have also uploaded a copy to www.risca.org.uk under the “parents” tab.

The judgements for the main areas are all either “good” or “adequate” with the overall judgements on the school being “adequate.” Estyn defines “adequate” as meaning “strengths outweigh areas for improvement” and the report contains much which is very positive as we might expect given the improvements we have made over the last two years.
