Dear Parent / Carer,

We are now entering the main period of GCSE examinations. There is plenty of information for pupils and parents on the school website including revision guidance and, of course, the examination timetable.

Pupils will be required to attend school up to and including Thursday 26th May. A number of revision sessions are being put in place, as well as normal lessons. When a pupil has a lesson in which they no longer have an examination they will be expected to do work from another subject.

There is a GCSE Maths exam on the morning of the 26th May. Following this the pupils will be allowed to sign each other's shirts (which has become something of a tradition in schools). We ask that pupils bring in a separate shirt for this purpose. Lessons after break will then continue for option subjects for which an examination is still to be taken and there is also an extra English Literature revision session which has been arranged for that day.

On 27th May and after half term pupils must attend for examinations and for those lessons for which they still have examinations, although there is provision for them to attend all the time if they wish to do so, or when they have a break between exams/lessons and it is impractical to go home.

The next few weeks are crucial for your child's future. I would like to take this opportunity to wish everyone the very best of luck.
